Hello, everyone. We have a few items to share with you this month.

Bear Tracker GPS phone

This small cell phone is the perfect tool for a parent to keep track of a child throughout the day. The parent can set four phone numbers that can interact with the **Bear Tracker GPS** phone. Once these numbers are set, the phone can call any of those four, and only those four phone numbers. Likewise, only those four numbers can call into the **Bear Tracker** phone.



Best of all, the **Bear Tracker GPS** phone sends out its GPS location to a server, or can text the address, GPS coordinates, or a Google map telling exactly where the **Bear Tracker** phone is located. There is also a monitor mode where the parent can text the phone to call back so the parent can listen in on what is going on at the phone's location.



Uses 2G or 3G GPRS SIM cards and wireless plans sold by wireless (cell service) carriers.

AD Head Pointers with **NEW** iPad Tips!

Our three head pointers have just been upgraded to include a brand new tip that is intended for use with **iPad**, **iPhone**, and **iPod Touch**, as well as other touch screen tablets including **Android** and all other AAC dynamic display devices. They still utilize the original design whereby the pointer comes from the chin, making it easier to see and make selections.

Grid Player on iOS 6



We have learned that some people are experiencing Grid Player crashes since they upgraded to iOS 6. Sensory Software is aware of the problem and they are working on long term solutions. For the moment they have offered two suggestions.

First, uninstall then reinstall Grid Player to your iOS device. This may solve the problem to have the Grid Player installed fresh after the iOS upgrade. The second idea is to hold off on upgrading to iOS 6 for now.
